SUMMER SESSION

The B.E.S.T. Program is offered during the University of Dayton's second summer session, from July 11 to Aug. 5, 2016.

TUITION

\$6,500 pays for housing, meal plan, activities and six hours of college credit from UD, which may be transferred to any college or university.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to any student who has completed at least their sophomore year of high school.

APPLICATION

The early action deadline is Friday, Feb. 12, 2016, and the regular application deadline is Friday, April 15, 2016. Space is limited.
