- **HIS 1111 will be transferred to the University of Dayton as HST 1XX effective Fall 2018.**
- **It is recommended that students take at least 15 hours per semester at Sinclair.**
- **124 hours minimum are required for the BSE.**
- **54 semester hours must be taken at the 300/400 level and the last 30 semester hours must be taken at the University of Dayton.**
