

Q: I am arriving on Thursday. Is there anything planned for Thursday evening?

A: Yes! We will be gathering at The Dayton Beer Co (41 Madison St., Dayton 45402). We will be offering a shuttle from the Marriott to the Dayton Beer Co. The shuttles will leave from the main entrance of the Marriott at 6 p.m. and at 6:15 p.m. The shuttles will then leave the Dayton Beer Co. at 9 p.m. only.
