It is argued that students need the full year of calculus to fully understand the material.</p> <p>It isn't agreed that students need the full-year of calculus to achieve the SLO's.</p> <p>Proposer argues that this program's purpose allows students to explore their interests and goals. And that through the advising process,</p>

				<p>students will be able to choose the appropriate sequence.</p> <p>Recommendations: There needs to be a change from six required credits to three to eight credits. Indicate what prerequisites and sequences are appropriate for students to choose. Ex. "Choose between one of the following sequences...".</p> <p>There are discrepancies between the attached document and the form on the Online Catalog.</p> <p>Concentration should be 15 credits total instead of 16.</p>
