OLD BUSINESS:

Policy Item: (Sense of the AAC): Should we have a policy on how many hours can double count between two majors or a major and a minor? The university does not have a policy, but SBA has their own policy in the Catalog: <http://catalog.udayton.edu/undergraduate/schoolofbusinessadministration/requirementsforthebaccalaureatedegree/> "Only 7 hours of course work can double count between two majors or a major and a minor." Policy Item discussed and tabled. The Executive Committee will be seeking a meeting with the assistant deans who initiated this policy item.

Meeting with Assistant Deans was held on October 3, 2018.

It is proposed that the Policy Committee be asked to meet and consider creating a policy for approval of interdisciplinary majors: limit the number or percentage of courses that can be taken in a single discipline to fulfill an interdisciplinary major.
