The Master of Public Administration (MPA) program at the University of Dayton is a NASPAA accredited, 39-hour program. The program of study consists of 27 semester hours of core classes and twelve (12) semester hours of electives. The MPA program will transfer between three (3) and twelve (12) semester hour equivalent credits from DAU courses as outlined in the table below. Upon admission to the MPA program, each student must meet with the MPA program director and petition for transfer credit on a case-by-case basis.
