PROFESSIONAL SCHOOL APPLICATION WORKSHOPS >>

Professional school application workshops will be held at 5:00 pm on Wednesday, April 8, and at 6:30 pm on Thursday, April 9 in SC 114. These workshops are for students intending to apply to medical or dental school this summer. They will be continuations of the application workshops in that were held in January. They will focus on the steps you will take in completing your AMCAS, AADSAS, or AACOMAS application. You need only attend one of these two workshops; the same content will be covered in both. These are important workshops for you to learn about the “next steps” in your application process..

AED BONE MARROW REGISTRY DRIVE >>

**6th Annual University of Dayton
and Miami Valley Hospital
Healthcare Symposium
March 28 2015**

The 6th Annual University of Dayton and Miami Valley Hospital Healthcare Symposium took place on March 28, 2015. Over 100 professionals and over 200 students attended the event.

The morning poster session included posters from many UD students and a few medical and graduate students from the Wright State University Boonshoft School of Medicine. There were posters in five different categories: Biomedical, Community Initiatives, International Health, Health Communications, and Professional Development.

The morning session titled "The Best Care Possible: A Patient-Centered Community Approach to Advance Care Planning" was hosted by Dr. Joseph Scherger. Speakers were Dr. Bernard Hammes, director of medical humanities

and Respecting Choices for Gunderson Health System, and Karen Peterson, director of program operations, Honoring Choices Minnesota, who both spoke about their organizations' efforts to coordinate community wide advance care planning initiatives. They were followed by a panel of local community leaders including Sen. Peggy Lehner speaking about related legislation in Ohio.

After the morning session, students and professionals enjoyed a luncheon.

Thank you to instructor Sam Kelly for providing the art work from his anatomy drawing class and for participating in the symposium.

The afternoon sessions began with a panel of doctors speaking about their specialties including anesthesiology and emergency medicine. There was also a PA panel featuring practicing PA's, PA school faculty and a PA student. The dental panel included a representative from the OSU College of Dentistry and several current dental students.

The second session of the afternoon featured a panel on Global Health and also a "Coffee with Professionals" session during which students could sit and have conversations with doctors, PA's, medical students and other health professionals.

The afternoon concluded with sessions focused on life in medical school, the application process and opportunities for a gap year.
