# UD/MVH Healthcare Symposium

## Description of Event

The University of Dayton/Miami Valley Healthcare Symposium is a unique opportunity for UD students, alumni and local physicians to come together for a day of dialogue and continuing education.

## Morning Session 9:00 am - 11:30 am

The morning session is open to physicians, other health professionals, students, faculty and staff. This year's symposium will feature Dr. Marjorie Bowman, Dean of Wright State University Boonshoft School of Medicine. Dr. Bowman will moderate a series of presentations by local experts in various areas of preventive medicine. Areas to be discussed include breast cancer screening, prostate cancer screening, coronary artery disease screenings, immunizations and the role of genetic testing.

## Luncheon and Luncheon Address 11:30 am - 1:00 pm

The topic "Healthcare Reform: Ohio 2013" will be discussed by Dr. Andrew Wapner, Chief Medical Officer at the Ohio Department of Health. Dr. Wapner is a board certified pediatrician and Clinical Assistant Professor of Pediatrics at The Ohio State University College of Medicine. Dr. Wapner will specifically address the Affordable Care Act and its implementation in the state of Ohio.

## Afternoon Sessions 1:15 pm - 3:15 pm

The afternoon **Student Symposium** is designed for students planning and preparing for a career in health care.

**PCMH: The New Landscape of Healthcare** will be presented by UD alumnus Dr. Joseph Scherger who will discuss the Patient Centered Medical Home. He describes this new model of medical care as "care coordination by a team independent of visits." This approach is proactive with the medical team reaching out to patients through a variety of methods to improve their care.

**Preparing your Pediatric Portfolio: Medical Student and Resident Perspectives** will be presented by Dr. Ranjana Sinha and some of her medical students and residents from Dayton Children's will speak about how to prepare for a medical career with a focus in pediatrics.

**Co-curricular Opportunities: Science, Healthcare and Service** - Learn about some opportunities in research, service, and clinical experiences both on and off campus including international from some UD students who have participated these activities.

**Med Student Panel: Preparing for Med School** - A panel of first year medical students will address issues related to the medical school application and decision making process and discuss the undergraduate experiences that helped them prepare to be successful medical school applicants.

**Med Student Panel: Life in Med School** - A panel of second and third year medical students will talk about their lives in medical school from both a curricular and co-curricular perspective.

**So You Wanna Be a PA?** - Sue Wulff, Director of UD's PA program and a practicing PA will speak about preparing for a career as a PA, PA school admissions, and PA as a career.

**Opportunities in Dentistry** - Several dentists from the local Small Smiles Dental Center will talk about their work and opportunities for students to get involved in the Small Smiles clinic here in Dayton.

**Exploring Health Career Options: Optometry, Podiatry and Pharmacy** - If you are interested in a career in health care but not sure what opportunities are available; this is a panel to help you learn about more options.
