

Requirements for a minor in psychology

A minor in psychology requires 18 psychology hours, including:

- PSY 101:** Introductory Psychology
- One course from:
 - **PSY 321:** Cognitive Processes
 - **PSY 322:** Learning
 - **PSY 323:** Psychology of Perception
 - **PSY 422:** Physiological Psychology
- One course from:
 - **PSY 341:** Social Psychology
 - **PSY 351:** Child Psychology
 - **PSY 361:** Personality
 - **PSY 363:** Abnormal Psychology
- An additional **9 hours of upper level (300/400) psychology courses.**

Only 3 hours of PSY 477, 478, 490, 493, 494, or 497 may count toward the minor.
