The intern will be expected to work in the Women's Center for 8-10 hours per week and will receive 6 credit hours of WGS course credit for the year - long internship. Completing the internship will fulfill half of the requirements toward a WGS minor.

- At least 6 credit hours of WGS and/or policy-related course work (Courses not listed as WGS courses but with significant gender focus count!)
- A clear commitment to gender equity and inclusion
- Excellent oral and written communication skills
