1920: Death of the child visionary of Fatima, Jacinta Marto.

Memorial of the Flight of the Holy Family into Egypt

Feast of St. Gabriel Possenti (1838-1862), a Passionist cleric who especially honored the Sorrowful Mother. Canonized in 1930, honored as patron of youth.

First Sunday of Lent, Feast of Orthodoxy or the Icon (Second Council of Nicea, 787) Fifth Saturday of Lent: Memorial of the Akathistos Hymn (Byzantine Church) Memorial, Mary, Mother of Reconciliation, disciple of the Lord under the cross.
