



**The University of Dayton Bachelor's Plus Master's (BPM) program encourages UD undergraduate students to continue their studies and complete a Master's Degree at UD.**

## Highlights of the BPM Program

- BPM Program participants receive a tuition discount based upon one-half of the prevailing undergraduate tuition rate
- Tuition discount extends to 12 consecutive months after graduation from undergraduate studies
- Students have the ability to take a semester off for an approved internship or co-op without penalty

## BPM Application Process

- Students need to have a GPA of 3.0 or better
- Acceptance into the BPM does not automatically mean acceptance into the MBA program
- Students should apply to the MBA Program using the MBA application online

Please submit the BPM application at the beginning of your senior year, but no later than your last semester as an undergraduate (or subsequent to completion of 60 semester hours of undergraduate work and prior to be awarded the baccalaureate degree) and complete the Graduate School application (available online through the Office of Admission).

## MBA Program Admission Requirements

- Prepare for the GMAT or GRE exam and submit official scores
- Submit copy of all transcripts from other schools (do not need to submit UD transcripts as they can be obtained by the MBA office directly)
- E-mail resume to [MBA@udayton.edu](mailto:MBA@udayton.edu)
- Submit an optional letter of recommendation and personal statement

## MBA Course Registration

- In order to stay in good academic standing and to graduate with an MBA, students need to maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA in the MBA courses
- Program consists of a minimum of 30 credit hours thus creating a need for a transitional semester (1st semester of MBA classes where both UG and MBA classes can be taken consecutively) and/or summer MBA classes to complete program within one academic year
- Non-business undergraduate students may also qualify for the BPM program. This program consists of 45 credit hours
- Students should work with the MBA office to ensure planned graduation requirements are being met

## MBA Concentrations

MBA electives can be used to complete an optional concentration in Accounting, Finance, Marketing, or Cyber Security. Finance, Marketing, and Cyber Security concentrations require 9 elective hours in the respective discipline. AACSB accreditation mandates 12 elective hours in Accounting to obtain a concentration.

Students must inform the MBA office in writing if declaring a concentration. Some concentrations are limited and have specific criteria for acceptance.

## Financial Aid

- All BPM students are eligible for a tuition discount for up to 12 consecutive months after graduation from undergraduate studies
- A limited number of GA positions are available. These positions are highly competitive and available within and outside the school of business. Most positions offer 50% tuition coverage and a modest bi-monthly stipend. Contact the MBA office to express your interest in GA positions within the school of business
