New Certification Programs Coming Soon

The University of Dayton MBA Program is pleased to announce that the School of Business Administration has launched three new MIS certification programs for post-baccalaureate students. In addition to the Cyber Security certificate already offered, the SBA will also offer Business Intelligence, Business Systems Analysis and Design, and Project Management.

As with the Cyber Security certificate, these certificates' completed courses may be counted as the three required MBA electives if candidates choose to also pursue an MBA. **In addition, these certificates may be earned as post-master's certificates.**



UD Online MBA Program

The University of Dayton has created a new online MBA Program to reach an even wider demographic of students than ever before. The online format also ensures that students are afforded the flexibility to continue their career while working toward educational goals and managing life's other responsibilities.

Throughout the program students will not only gain the opportunity to expand their professional network, but they will develop applicable, real-world business skills through our signature core courses in topics such as Managerial Economics; Integrating Faith, Ethics, and Work; Modeling and Analysis for Business Decisions; Performance Control and Measurement; Operational Effectiveness; Information systems and Business Decisions; Organizational Behavior; Marketing Management; Corporate Finance; and Business Strategy, among others.

To demonstrate mastery of the coursework, students will undertake a project integrating the above topics and implementing them in a real-world situation, just as our students do in our traditional MBA program.




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Last Thoughts
