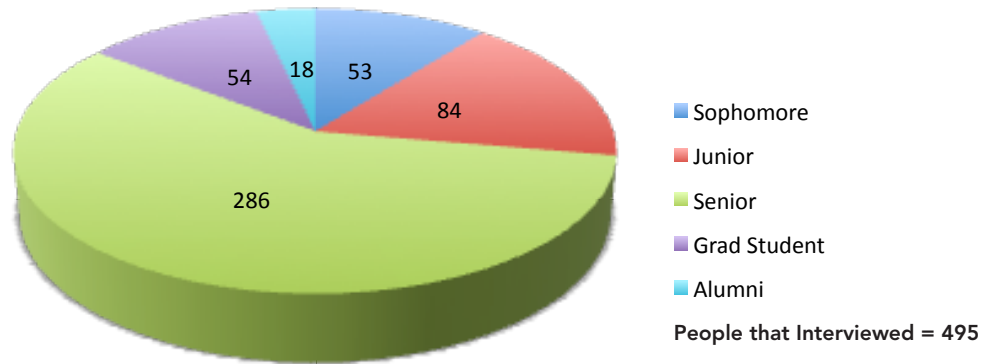

Come prepared to Career Fairs. Do more research on companies you plan on speaking with

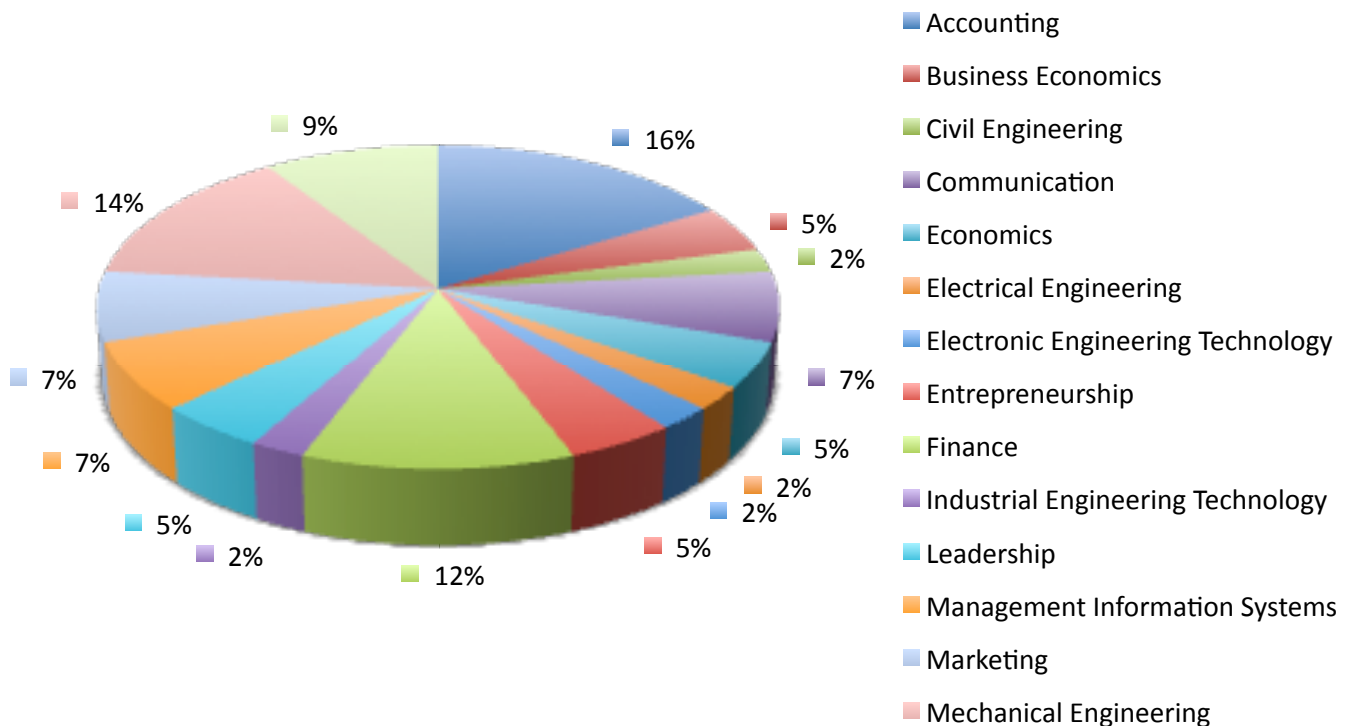
Overall, they did well.

The more internships they can do the better. They seem to be more well-rounded and already can offer some relevant work experience and knowledge.

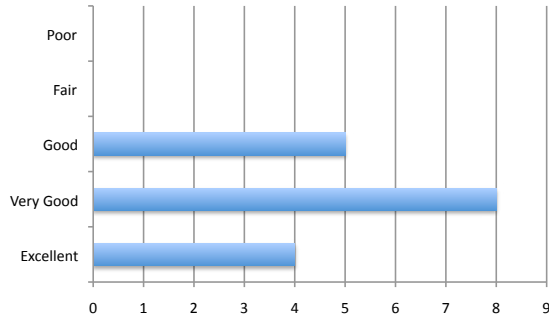
