The University of Dayton Center for Leadership is excited to announce the launch of our **Supervisory Leadership Certificate Program** in Dublin, Ohio beginning in August 2017. This leadership program for new and experienced supervisors began in 2011, and has since helped hundreds of leaders flourish in their roles as supervisors.

The Supervisory Leadership Certificate Program is a 10-day leadership development program presented over 6 months for leaders in public, private and not-for-profit organizations. This interactive program will assist new and experienced front-line leaders in developing those critical skills necessary to maximize individual and team performance.

The UD Center for Leadership currently hosts more than 200 days of leadership development programs annually, for leaders throughout Ohio and the midwest including alumni and employers located near the Dublin area. With four Supervisor Leadership Certificate cohort programs hosted on our main campus in Dayton, this expansion to the University of Dayton Dublin, Ohio campus will enable us to collectively develop stronger leaders and supervisors throughout the Central Ohio region.

Participants will leave this program with a solid foundation of leadership and practical skills that can immediately be applied to become a more effective supervisor.
