Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)**

Where is the building located?

The building is located one mile southwest of the main campus at 1700 Patterson Boulevard across from Carillon Park, on the east side of the street (same side as Marriott hotel). You will see international flags in front of the building. Here's a look: http://www.mapquest.com/mq/5-9SF_03yjwFmf

PARKING

I currently don't have a parking pass, what do I do?

All students will need a UD parking pass, which can be purchased from Parking Services online at: <http://www.udayton.edu/studev/publicsafety/parking/>

Where do I park at this facility?

There is ample parking in R1 lot on the south side of the building. Both faculty and students will park in this south lot, which is closest to Oakwood. When turning onto the campus, cross the bridge and turn right. Follow the driveway to the south side of the building.

BUILDING ACCESS

How do I get access to the building?

You will need to use your current University of Dayton ID to enter the building. Your ID must have the magnetic strip enabled for the card reader to work. There should be a set of numbers under the strip to the left. The OneCard staff will activate your card remotely prior to your first class in the building.

Where do I get my University ID?

It is recommended that you obtain your ID as soon as possible as you will not be allowed entrance into the building without an ID card. You can obtain an ID by visiting the OneCard Office on UD's main campus. This is located in the Powerhouse building directly in front of the Humanities building. You also can apply via email by sending a message to: flyercard@udayton.edu. The email should contain: 1) Full name 2) Address and Phone 3) UD student number 4) Email address 5) Electronic photo (head shot) The student will be notified via email by Campus Card Services when the card is ready to be picked up on the main campus.

Where do I enter the building?

Please enter on the south side next to the parking lot. There are elevators, restrooms, and stairs nearby. No student access is permitted through the front of the building.

Where are the classrooms located?

All the classrooms are located on the second floor. If you have not yet been in the building, it is highly recommend that you arrive at least twenty minutes before your regular class time to find your classroom, etc.

FOOD SERVICE AND CAFETERIA

Will food service be available?

There are vending machines available on the second floor.

Will there be team rooms or other student meeting spaces?

There are several conference rooms and team rooms on the second floor available for students. The GPCE will be booking these rooms.

Who do I contact if there is an emergency in the building?
