SECTION I - PREREQUISITE COURSES: Students seeking the Early Childhood and Early Intervention Specialist Licenses as an initial license need a foundational understanding of instruction for kindergarten and the primary grades. At least 16 hours of prerequisites must be completed before being admitted to the cohort group.
