Oral Proficiency Interview: The American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages (ACTFL) Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI) and the Writing Proficiency Test (WPT) are required with a rating of intermediate low or higher.

Study Abroad: Participation in an approved study abroad immersion program is highly recommended. The OPI and WPT should be taken immediately upon return.
