Standards of Conduct for Educator Licensure Candidates
Statement of Assurance of Good Moral Character**

A person shall be deemed to be of “good moral character” provided that said individual has not pled guilty to, or been convicted of any felony and/or misdemeanor delineated by the Ohio Revised Code or other comparable municipal, State or Federal offense. Some offenses are permanently disqualifying for educator licensing or employment, ref. O.R.C. 3319.31. Other offenses may be deemed subject to rehabilitation, but are subject to strict guidelines and determination by higher authorities. See conditions specified in rule 3301-20-01 of the Ohio Administrative Code. Permanently disqualifying offenses generally include crimes of violence, sex offenses, and other felonies. Student signature of this form shall be considered evidence that the student has read these materials and thereby acknowledges their content. Moreover, in each academic year in which a student shall be placed in a field experience, the student shall consent to a criminal background check.
