## FULL TUITION + MONTHLY STIPEND APPLY TO GRADUATE SCHOOL BY MARCH 31, 2018!

The University of Dayton School of Engineering has several assistantship positions available for the 2018–19 academic year. Assistantships are annual, renewable and include tuition plus a monthly stipend. Both master’s and doctoral students may apply. Positions are available in all engineering departments and include teaching assistant or research assistant responsibilities.

To be considered, students must meet the following requirements:

1. GPA of 3.5 or greater
2. GRE score > 325 combined
3. GRE analytical writing score of 4.5 or greater
4. Graduate school application submitted in full. No separate application required.

Current University of Dayton undergraduate and graduate students are not eligible for assistantships. Underrepresented minorities and women are encouraged to apply. Assistantship recipients will be notified no later than May 1, 2018.
