Effective fall semester 2016, the Office of Student Success (OSS) will be advising all incoming First Year students and will continue to work with these students through December of their sophomore year. The advisors will use the Student Success Network through the Porches Flyer First/Student Accounts area to inform students of walk-in advising hours as well as enable them to make appointments with their assigned academic advisor.
