<p><b>Outcome Two -- Measures Utilized</b></p> <p><b>Outcome 2 - Community:</b> All sociology majors will demonstrate experience in the study of community in departmental courses and most will participate in volunteer community service projects.</p> <p><b>Measure 1</b> - Seventy-five percent (75%) of majors will participate in volunteer community service projects. Measure: Exit interview/questionnaire.</p> <p><b>Measure 2</b> - Twenty percent (20%) of all majors will participate in at least one of the department's community based or field courses: the SOC 497 Service Learning Experience course and/or an internship course and/or an independent study course and/or SOC 204L focused specifically on community study. Measure: Exit interview/questionnaire/transcript.</p> <p><b>Measure 3</b> - All majors will demonstrate understanding of community through research and writing assignments. Measure: Grade of C or above on community-based research project from Outcome 1.</p>	<p>Twenty-five (25) out of 33 (76%) of graduating majors surveyed reported that they engaged in voluntary community service.</p> <p>Six (6) out of 33 (18%) graduating majors surveyed participated in one of the department's community-based or field courses.</p> <p>Twenty-nine (29) out of 33 majors received a grade of C or better in the Senior Seminar (SOC 409) which requires a research-based community project. One student is completing an independent study project for the course.</p>
