<p>Outcome Two -- Measures Utilized</p> <p>Outcome 2 - Community: All sociology majors will demonstrate experience in the study of community in departmental courses and most will participate in volunteer community service projects.</p> <p>Measure 1 - Seventy-five percent (75%) of majors will participate in volunteer community service projects. Measure: Exit interview/questionnaire.</p> <p>Measure 2 - Twenty percent (20%) of all majors will participate in at least one of the department's community based or field courses: the SOC 497 Service Learning Experience course and/or an internship course and/or an independent study course and/or SOC 204L focused specifically on community study. Measure: Exit interview/questionnaire/transcript.</p> <p>Measure 3 - All majors will demonstrate understanding of community through research and writing assignments. Measure: Grade of C or above on community-based research project from Outcome 1.</p>	<p>Twenty-three (23) out of 30 (77%) of graduating majors surveyed reported that they engaged in voluntary community service.</p> <p>Thirteen (13) out of 30 (43%) graduating majors surveyed participated in one of the department's community-based or field courses or Semester of Service through the Fitz Center.</p> <p>Thirty (30) out of 34 majors received a grade of C or better in the Senior Seminar (SOC 409) which requires a research-based community project.</p>
