<p data-bbox="110 369 461 394">Outcome Three C Measures Utilized</p> <p data-bbox="110 428 781 537">Outcome 3: Students will develop skills in philosophical research including use of philosophical indexes, encyclopedias, bibliographies, Ohiolink, CD ROM capabilities, and other emerging technologies as appropriate.</p> <p data-bbox="204 569 797 705">Measure 1: Students in seminar courses will complete an information form about the use of research tools related to the seminar. 90% of seminar students in any year will agree that they have developed skills in this area and will be able to identify those skills.</p> <p data-bbox="204 764 797 846">Measure 2: The Department review committee will agree that 90% of students exhibit use of research skills in the work submitted for department assessment.</p>	<p data-bbox="824 569 1511 705">Measure 1: As noted last year, the current form is not entirely adequate for measuring this outcome. In 2003-04 the department will replace the form with a research skills workshop. Approximately 100% [n=34] of seminar students this year demonstrated that they could identify research skills they used in their seminar courses.</p> <p data-bbox="824 764 1511 846">Measure 2: The review committee judged that 87.5% [7 out of 8] of the papers submitted in the "research skills" category demonstrated appropriate research skills.</p>
