<p><i>Outcome Two - Measures Utilized</i></p> <p>For those students who participate in the Co-Op program or have internships, their experience in those programs will further their professional development.</p> <p>2a) 90% of Co-Op evaluations conducted by employers rate the students' overall performance as good or excellent.</p> <p>2b) 90% of the Co-Op student reports submitted at the end of each work term indicate that the coop experience improved their understanding of the role of computing in industry and furthered their knowledge of the discipline.</p> <p>2c) At the time of the exit interview, 90% of students who had co-ops or internships will strongly agree or agree with the statement: "My co-op/internship experience has helped me in the interviewing and job search process."</p>	<p>2a) 6 of 6 evaluations (100%) rated performance as good or excellent. The remaining employers did not provide an evaluation.</p> <p>2b) 13 of 13 student reports (100%) indicated a significantly improved understanding of the discipline.</p> <p>2c) 3 graduates reported having internships or participating in the CO-OP program. 100% either strongly agreed or agreed with the statement.</p>
