<p>Hierarchy of Titles</p> <p>The University will use a hierarchy of titles when naming positions. In using these titles the following principles should be kept in mind:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Attempt to minimize the total number of different titles used within a single division. 2. Attempt to be very sparing in the use of the title "Vice President" alone or in conjunction with other terms. 3. Attempt to use the term "Associate" sparingly in titles and normally restrict its use to an area where there is the tradition of distinguishing between "Assistant" and "Associate." 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Relationship of Titles With Pay Ranges

The University has a series of pay ranges which it uses to denote the grade of an administrative position. While there is necessarily variability in the pay of persons with the same level of titles because of the actual scope of the position, the University does attempt to maintain some correlation between title and pay grade. The following is a listing of a general correlation of pay grade with title.

The above listing does not attempt to show a correlation of title with pay grades E and F since there are few positions at these two levels and actual compensation is largely determined by external factors such as "market defined rates", experience and the like.
