Get quality care at retail health clinics

As you drive home from work, you think about your errands. On your list: go to the bank, buy groceries and make dinner. And that sore throat that's been bothering you? It's time to get that checked, too.

Your primary doctor may be your first choice when you need care. But now you have another option – retail health clinics.

Health care services right where you shop

You don't need an appointment to get care at retail health clinics. You can find most of them at drugstores and large stores. The clinics are usually open on the same days and hours as the store. Most clinics are open weekends and evenings.

Retail health clinics offer care for common illnesses. You can also get wellness and prevention services. These include camp physicals and cholesterol and diabetes screenings.

Retail health clinics are staffed by physician assistants and/or nurse practitioners. An offsite doctor is available by phone for consultation. If needed, you will be referred to local doctors or hospitals for care.

You can visit a retail health clinic for:

- Minor allergies.
- Bumps, cuts, scrapes.
- Cough, sore throat.
- Minor fevers, colds.
- Ear or sinus pain.
- Eye swelling or irritation.
- Rashes, minor burns.
- Burning with urination.

Treatment may vary by location. Call the retail health clinic before you go.

Retail health clinics also offer vaccines:

- DTaP (diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis)
- Hepatitis A and B
- Influenza
- Meningitis
- MMR (measles, mumps and rubella)
- Pneumonia
- Polio
- Td (tetanus and diphtheria)

To find a retail health clinic near you:

1. Log on to [anthem.com](https://www.anthem.com) and choose your coverage type. Click on Continue.
2. Click on Find a Doctor, listed under Useful Tools.
3. Select "Urgent Care".
4. Select "Retail Health Clinic" as the specialty listed under About the Provider.
5. Enter your city and state or zip.
6. Click on Search.
