

2024 Open Enrollment for Retirees Under 65

For 2024, Anthem will continue to administer the retiree medical plans--Core and Advantage. Superior Dental Care and CVS Caremark will remain for 2024 as well. We continue to work to keep rising costs in check while maintaining a high level of coverage.

There will be no changes to plan benefits for 2024. There is no requirement to use a CVS pharmacy to fill your medications. As a retiree or spouse enrolled in the healthcare plans, you will NOT be receiving new ID cards from Anthem this year. Continue to use your current ID card/s for 2024.

To continue your current benefits without changes, no action is required. If you want to enroll for the first time in dental coverage or make changes to your plan, you must complete the Enrollment/Change Form. If you want to cancel your existing coverage, you must complete the Waiver section of the Enrollment/Change form. All forms must be submitted to the Office of Human Resources by the deadline.

No forms will be accepted after the deadline of Nov. 6, 2023.
