Sec. 27 PROCUREMENT INTEGRITY

Sec. 27 (a) PROHIBITED CONDUCT BY COMPETING CONTRACTORS. – during the conduction of any Federal agency procurement of property or services, no competing contractor or any office, employee, representative, agent, or consultant of any competing contractor shall knowingly—

1. Make, directly or indirectly, an offer or promise of future employment or business opportunity to, or engage, directly or indirectly, in any discussion of future employment or business opportunity with, any procurement official of such agency;
2. Offer, give, or promise to offer or give, directly or indirectly, any money, gratuity, or other thing of value in any procurement official of such agency; or
3. Solicit or obtain, directly or indirectly, from any officer or employee of such agency, prior to the award of a contract any proprietary or source selection information regarding such procurement.
