ArtStreet and Studio Theatre is looking for playwrights to submit brand new or already written scripts for the premiere White Box Theatre Festival, a series of 1 to 30 minute plays to be presented November 4-6, 2014, as part of ArtStreet's IMPACT exhibition. Eight to ten plays will be produced and performed in a unique repertory design within the ArtStreet installation that will 'inspire and foster alternative theatrical performance through the process of composing, revising and nurturing original short scripts.'

Script submissions should draw inspiration from the works featured in University Libraries' landmark exhibit, [IMPRINTS AND IMPRESSIONS: Milestones in Human Progress](#). These works should serve as the creative foundation to each script, which will be placed into a development, casting and incubation process that will occur throughout the fall semester. Selected scripts will require a willingness to revise and polish the script as the play is produced. A student director will be paired with each playwright who will collaborate on the play development with a professional Artist-In-Resident.
