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If you are unable to complete your academic program within the period specified on the I-20, you must request to extend your I-20 to remain in the US legally. **The request to extend the I-20 program must be submitted at least 30 days before the program end date listed on the I-20.** A program extension cannot be granted after this date. The following are *not* valid reasons for I-20 extensions:

- To enroll in extra courses for personal/academic interest or to improve one's GPA
- To finish minor requirements
- To engage in research on or off-campus
- To finish pending coursework (i.e. rectify an incomplete grade)
- To repeat a course for a better grade
- To engage in Curricular Practical Training (CPT) after completing all degree requirements

To request an extension, submit the following:

1. A completed *Request to Extend I-20* form.
2. Proof of financial support for remainder of your program. Financial support can come in one or a combination of the following:
 - a. A personal bank statement (yours not your relatives)
 - b. A family member's bank statement + affidavit of support
 - c. Letter of financial guarantee (sponsored students only)
