

**CALL FOR ENTRIES:
REVEAL: CITIZENS OF THE WORLD 2017**

The Institute of Applied Creativity for Transformation (IACT) at ArtStreet and the Center for International Programs is seeking creative submissions for the 2017 Citizens of the World (COTW) student installation: REVEAL. The 12th annual Citizens of the World installation will take place March 9- April 6, 2017, at the White Box Gallery at ArtStreet. ***If your creative submission is selected for the installation, we ask that you attend the opening event during the evening on March 9, 2016, time TBD, at ArtStreet.***

Submission Guidelines:

The 2017 Citizens of the World installation will highlight students' experiences through visual and expressive storytelling that **reveal** a moment or experience that represents a turning point in your personal journey or QUEST.

Acceptable submissions include....

- Written word/short stories/poetry
- Music compositions and/or lyrics and/or recordings
- Photographs/visual art/installation art designs
- Performance-based art/scripts
- Videos
- Artifacts

For each submission, a 3-5 sentence written reflection should be included that explains: **“How or why does this submission reveal a moment or experience that represents a turning point in your personal journey or QUEST?”**

As well, please submit your name, major, year in school and country of origin.

Students may submit up to three entries.

How to submit....

Photographs: Please submit high resolution (1500x2000 pixels minimum) .jpg files

2-D/3-D work/artifacts: Please submit a hi-resolution image of the work or object; original work must be available from Feb. 24 - April 7 for the set-up and duration of the installation.

Videos: Please submit a .mp4 or .mov file, preferably via a link to a Dropbox or Google Drive file rather than emailing original file.

Written Works: Please submit a word document (.doc or .docx), unless your submission includes a specific layout design, in which case submit as .pdf.

Submissions should be sent to cip@udayton.edu by midnight on **November 28, 2016.**

By submitting your work, you give permission for IACT at ArtStreet and CIP to use your work and images in the installation, as well as promotional materials for Citizens of the World (postcard, website, etc.). Final selections for the installation are at the discretion of the committee, and not all submissions will be selected. Citizens of the World installation images are sometimes used for general University marketing purposes. We may contact you if your submission is selected for this purpose.
