Thanks to the tremendous support of you and your fellow alumni, this spring we will celebrate the graduation of the first students from our Leadership Honors Program (LHP). These lawyer-leaders will go into the world to carry forward our profession's noble legacy of thoughtful leadership, and it would not have been possible without your help in nominating outstanding students for the Program. With that in mind, I invite you to nominate a student for a full-tuition Leadership Honors Program scholarship for the 2017-18 admissions cycle. Below is a reminder of how the nomination system works.

The Nomination System

Because the LHP is limited in size, all candidates must be nominated by *designated nominators*. As a distinguished alumnus of the Law School, you are a designated nominator and may nominate one student for the LHP. You may nominate an LHP candidate either before or after they apply to the Law School for JD admission. But, please note, even nominated and accepted Leadership Honors candidates **MUST APPLY TO AND BE ADMITTED INTO THE JD PROGRAM.**

Admissions Criteria

The tuition-free scholarships we award constitute a tremendous honor for recipients, so please consider your nominee carefully. The minimum *quantitative* criteria are an undergraduate GPA of 3.15 and an LSAT score of 152. *Qualitatively*, we are looking for students who have held leadership positions or who have shown unique creativity, perseverance or allegiance to principle.

Deadline

Due to the high level of interest in the program, the priority deadline to submit a nomination is **January 5**. We will consider nominations after that date, but applicants will be reviewed depending on space availability.
