- **A group of 10 volunteers to bag groceries at the St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry. The Food Pantry is located at 945 S. Edwin C Moses Blvd and is inside the St. Vincent de Paul Thrift Store.**
- **A group of up to 30 volunteers to assist with various projects within the Job Center. The Job Center is located at 1111 - 1133 S. Edwin C Moses Blvd. The specific projects will be determined closer to the day of the event and they may include but are not limited to landscaping, painting, moving equipment/furniture, etc.**

Directions to The Job Center located at 1111 - 1133 S. Edwin C Moses Blvd and The St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry is located inside the St. Vincent de Paul Thrift Store (next door to The Job Center) at 945 S. Edwin C Moses Blvd: From US-35, exit at the Main/Jefferson Street(s) and go forward. You will pass Chaminade Julianne High School on your right. You will go across the river via the Washington Street Bridge and turn left. The Job Center and St. Vincent de Paul Thrift Store will be on your right.
