Applicants for the award should possess a record of contributing their time and talent for the good of the student body and the law school community generally.

Scholarship Value and Terms

These scholarships, each with values of \$1000-\$3000, will be awarded to students who will be in their second or third year of law school during the Fall 2012/Spring 2013 academic year. The awards will be credited to the recipients' tuition charges for the Fall 2012/ Spring 2013 academic year.

Criteria for Consideration

Consideration will be given to:

1. contributions made to the academic and/or student environment of the University of Dayton School of law;
2. academic performance as a law student;
3. demonstration of financial need as verified by the University Financial Aid Office

Application Process and Time Frame

Current first and second-year law students who are in good academic standing may apply for the Service Award by providing responses to the following questions. These responses and a resume should be submitted to lawinfo@udayton.edu or to the Office of Admissions, Keller Hall Room 112, no later than **Wednesday, April 18, 2012**. Selection of the award recipients will be made in late Spring 2012.
