November 3rd is the deadline for submitting an Exam Accommodation/Deferral Form. Exam Accommodation Request forms are available in the Registrar's Office, Room 203, Keller Hall, and are available on the web in PDF.

- Pursuant to the Policy Manual (page 27), exams are rescheduled in only two circumstances:
- (a) When a student has two or more exams scheduled to begin during a twenty-four hour period (a 1:30 PM examination followed by an 8:30 AM examination the next day presents a conflict; however, an 8:30 AM examination followed by an 8:30 examination the next day does not); or
 - (b) When extraordinary and unavoidable circumstances intervene (such as a serious health problem of a student or a close family member).

The Associate Dean for Academic Affairs reviews, and if appropriate, approves exam deferral requests. Upon approval, the Registrar will reschedule the examination to the next available non-conflicting date, but not later than the third business day after the end of the examination period.
