

# Criminal Law Concentration Worksheet

This form is provided to assist you in planning and selecting courses if you are interested in pursuing a concentration in **Criminal Law**. Questions should be directed to the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs.

**To be admitted into the concentration, a student must:**

- ✓ **Submit a Declaration Form to the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs no later than the final day of class of the student's penultimate semester.**
- ✓ **Be certified by the Associate Dean as having met the requirements for admission to the concentration.**

**To receive this certificate, a student must:**

- ✓ **Have a cumulative GPA in all courses of 2.75 or above upon graduation.**
- ✓ **Complete a total of at least 14 credit hours in the courses listed below. At least 9 hours must be under grading option A.**
- ✓ **Earn a minimum of a 3.0 grade point average in the courses taken to satisfy the concentration.**
- ✓ **Complete and submit this form to the Registrar for verification four weeks prior to graduation.**
