### THE BASICS

- 90 Credits required for graduation.
- 12-18 Credits per regular semester (Fall & Spring).
- You are not permitted to take over 16 credits total if you are below a 2.5 CGPA.

### KEY DATES

- **March 26, 8:00 am** – Summer online registration opens.
- **May 7 – July 26** – Upper-Level Summer session.
- **Wednesday, April 4, 8:00 am** – Fall online registration opens for students graduating in 2020.

### REQUIREMENTS

- Legislation (must be taken in 3<sup>rd</sup> semester)
- Constitutional Law I (must be taken in the 3<sup>rd</sup> semester)
- Legal Profession II (must be taken in the 3<sup>rd</sup> semester if you had ELA this semester)
- Contracts II (must be taken in the 3<sup>rd</sup> semester)
- Constitutional Law II (must be taken in the 4<sup>th</sup> semester [Spring 2019])
- Fundamentals of Evidence Upper Level Writing Requirement (Appellate Practice & Procedure **OR** Transactional Drafting)- **Must be fulfilled before taking the Capstone in the final year**
- ADR (Choose from ADR for the Litigator **OR** Interviewing, Counseling & Negotiation)
- Professional Responsibility
- Real Property II
- Criminal Procedure: Investigative
- Bar Practice & Process
- Required coursework **after** the second year: Externship **OR** Clinic and Capstone
