

Roesch Library welcomes visitors and visiting scholars with educational and research needs not being met in a neighborhood library. While our collections and services are staffed and funded to serve the scholarly needs of the University of Dayton faculty, students, and staff, we strive to provide reasonable access to the collections, computers, and facilities for all users. We do make a distinction between access (library use) and borrowing (home use) privileges. UD students, staff, and faculty have priority for all services and computers. As a depository of government publications, Library staff will make accommodation for users needing access to online US government publications. Accommodation could include asking others to relinquish library computers. **The University maintains the right to limit access to the Library when it determines such limitations are warranted (e.g., when its policies are violated, security measures so require, etc.).**
