




# ATTEND ASSESSMENT SESSIONS WITH LINDA SUSKIE

Linda Suskie will argue that we need to focus on fighting complacency, breaking down silos, putting our money where our mouth is, being relevant and responsive to stakeholders, telling meaningful stories of our successes and, above all, providing every student with a great education.
