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**ACADEMIC COACHING AND CONSULTATIONS**

Discuss goals, motivation, transition to college, and study skills.  
Obtain referrals to campus and community resources.  
Request an informal disability screening. Come once or regularly, it's up to you.

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**COURSES OFFERED THROUGH OLR**

- **Academic Renewal Course & Coaching** (DEV 055, 1 credit) combines classroom work on learning and study skills with academic coaching.
- **The Art & Science of Learning** (UDI 175, 2 credits) explores the intersection of research in neuroscience, psychology, and educational psychology with your experience and needs in learning.
- **Learning Connections** (UDI 149, 2 credits) helps international students make connections between the science of learning and their past and present learning experiences. Learn ways to learn effectively in American college classes.

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**INTERNATIONAL STUDENT LEARNING SUPPORT**

Meet with staff or peer coaches, individually or in groups, or attend a seminar to develop skills for learning in a diverse community. Learn from an international or peer partner. Meet a faculty or staff member over coffee.

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**SERVICES FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES**

Meet with disability specialists for individual consultations and services including academic, residential, parking, and testing accommodations, alternative formats, assistive technology with training.

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**TUTORING**

Take advantage of tutoring with trained peer tutors for selected courses. Available to all students during listed hours.

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**ONLINE RESOURCES**

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**SUPPLEMENTAL INSTRUCTION (SI)**
