

Temporary Disability and/or Medical Conditions

The Office of Student Learning Services (SLS) works with students who experience temporary disabilities and/or medical conditions. Documentation and registration with SLS are required in order to receive temporary academic accommodations. Please note, temporary conditions affecting attendance only are not accommodated by SLS. If your condition is temporary but is impacting only attendance, make sure you follow up with your professors and contact the Dean of your program for additional support.

A temporary disability is generally associated with an unexpected medical condition that has an impact on the learning environment. This may include, but is not limited to writing, reading, testing, vision, mobility, and hearing. The student should submit documentation from their treating provider includes a diagnosis, functional limitations, recommendations, and anticipated duration. SLS Disability Staff will review all documentation provided and issue a determination letter. The student should contact SLS for an appointment to discuss appropriate accommodations for the duration of the disability. Students with temporary disabilities will be required to sign a Temp Contact acknowledging understanding of the time limit for temporary accommodations. Additional documentation will be required for consideration to continue academic accommodations, if the disability last longer than expected.

Please note that submission of documentation is not the same as the request for services. Student must meet with our Disability Staff after determination is processed to discuss next steps, if applicable.
