- Come prepared! Bring your textbook, class notes, and homework assignments. This provides our Tutors context.
- Bring your friends! Learning is a social act. Many of your classmates may have the same questions as you.
- Come with a plan. Our sessions last approximately 30 minutes. Use this time with a Tutor effectively.
- What specific questions do you have? Bring three pointed questions to help the Tutor understand your specific needs.
- Plan ahead. Seeking help the night before an exam is too late. Come a few days ahead of exams to give yourself time to study.
