Campus Ministry offers paid positions for undergraduate students as leaders and co-leaders of liturgical music at the weeknight residence hall and Sunday Masses. Applicants should be rising sophomores, juniors or seniors with musical and leadership abilities (vocal

and/or instrumental), an interest in learning about liturgy and liturgical principles, and a desire to explore music ministry as a vocation.

WHAT DO UGMM'S DO?

There are many opportunities to serve UD's liturgical community and the larger Church through music, and the structure of the Campus Ministry Liturgical Music program aims to excel in preparing students for informed and spirited participation both on campus and in parish music ministry after graduation. The five Sunday Masses and three Residence Hall weeknight Masses are made up of both volunteer singers and instrumentalists and paid student leaders.

HOW TO APPLY?

Applications are being accepted until the end of March. Once processed an audition/interview will be arranged. Pick up an application in Liberty Hall, Room 101 or from any of the current UGMM's after Mass in the chapel.
