## CONTROVERSIES IN PREVENTIVE MEDICINE:

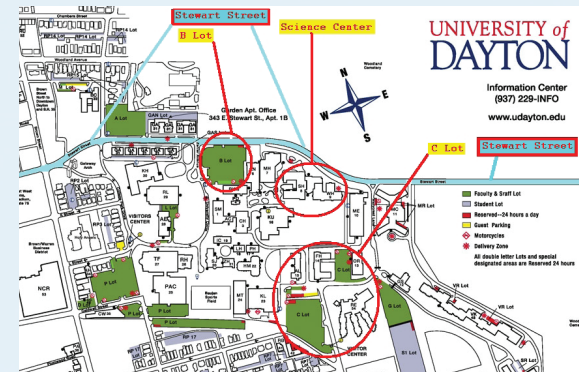
