

Marianist Student Communities

Inspired by the Marianist Charism of bringing the Gospel message of Jesus to our world, students commit to live together and be a witness of Christian community to their peers in the student neighborhood. The communities strive to incorporate the Marianist Charism and the Commitment to Community into their everyday lives.

Students living in intentional Marianist Student Communities (MSC) commit to the following expectations:

- Write a community mission statement based on the Marianist Spirit
- Be a praying community, gathering two or three times a week for prayer
- Share at least two or three meals together each week
- Attend Marianist formation in-services
- Meet regularly with Marianist mentors
- Engage the larger community as a house of hospitality through events that bring neighbors together in the Marianist spirit
- Collaborate with their respective Neighborhood Fellow and participate in his/her programs
- Following the rules and regulations in the University Student Handbook concerning gatherings and/or parties and the use of alcohol
- Participate in Catholic and Marianist activities on campus
