NSO registration will open on **July 6 at 1 p.m. EDT**. Please log into Porches to register both you and your family members. New Student Orientation begins on **August 20**. Residential students move-in between 7 – 11 a.m. All First-year students (residential and commuter) should report to the RecPlex for check-in on Sunday, August 21 at 9:15 a.m.

Family members are strongly encouraged to attend orientation events on **August 20**. Orientation events will continue for students until classes begin.

CAMP BLUE

Camp Blue is a high-energy, action-packed week exclusively for University of Dayton First-Year students. This six-night experience focuses on leadership and UD's philosophy — learn, lead and serve. Events are held on campus and at YMCA Camp Ernst in Northern Kentucky. The schedule is packed with a variety of leadership-building sessions and activities.

Registration will open at 1 p.m. on July 20 and will close at midnight on July 24. Only 115 spots are available, and a fee of \$300 is required at time of reservation to secure your space. BRIDGES—INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ORIENTATION

Bridges is a two day orientation especially designed for international students starting an academic program who are new to the University of Dayton. Bridges is your first and most important introduction to the university and the U.S. Attendance is required.
