NSO registration will open on **July 8**. Please log into Porches to register both you and your family members. New Student Orientation begins on **August 23**. Residential students move-in between 7 – 11 a.m. All First-year students (residential and commuter) should report to the RecPlex for check-in at 12:45 p.m.

Family members are strongly encouraged to attend orientation events on **August 23 and 24**. Orientation events will continue for students until classes begin.
