

MEMBERSHIP RATE FAQ'S

How does this apply to me if my current membership expires after September 30, 2016?

Any annual membership that is renewed prior to the end of September will be extended for one calendar year past the current expiration date.

Example: If my membership expires on 1/10/17 and I renew that membership before the end of September, my new expiration date will be 1/10/18.

Can I purchase multiple years of my membership at the current rate to lock in that lower rate for an extended period of time?

Only one year of membership can be added in advance of the current expiration date.

Why are certain membership rates increasing but not others?

The new membership rates reflect a desire to achieve a financially sustainable rate structure while asking for a more equitable financial contribution from all user groups.

Why are Family Memberships increasing in cost?

By increasing the rate for the Family Membership and leaving the "Single Family Member" membership at a lower cost, we hope to have a rate structure that more accurately represents an equitable contribution per individual user.
