	<u>Change</u> Improving the status quo and demonstrating comfort with ambiguity in the process of change	<u>Citizenship</u> Active engagement (not just membership) in community	<u>Common Purpose</u> Intentional work towards a unified goal	<u>Collaboration</u> The act of coming together and utilizing leadership as a group process	<u>Controversy with Civility</u> Appropriate civil discussions resolving with a common purpose	<u>Consciousness of Self</u> Awareness of beliefs, values, attitudes and emotions motivating one to take action	<u>Congruence</u> Understanding and being consistent with one’s own beliefs, values, strengths and limitations	<u>Commitment</u> Psychic energy that motivates the individual to serve and that drives the collected effort
